




SIGNIFICADO y CARACTERÍSTICAS

- Must: deber
- Must not (Mustn't): no deber
- Must es un verbo modal en inglés
- Después de este verbo modal NO se agrega <u>TO</u>.
- Se usa para el tiempo **presente** y futuro.
- Se usa para oraciones **afirmativas**
- y **negativas**. Siempre va acompañado de **otro**
- **No** se agrega <u>S</u> en tercera persona.

• Employees must not sleep in the office. / Los empleados *no deben* dormir en la oficina.



Expresa obligación desde un nivel <u>subjetivo</u> (punto de vista personal) o desde una perspectiva <u>objetiva</u> (externa) como una ley natural, social, jurídica o administrativa (reglas, procedimientos, manuales, etc.)

Sujeto + Must / Mustn't+ verbo base + complemento

* I must call my boss. / Debo llamar a mi jefe. (presente)

* You must come tomorrow. / Debes venir mañana. (futuro)
